Since 1978, VIA has received a half cent of local sales tax, plus a 1/8-cent share that voters approved in 2004. Every other major Texas city — Austin, Houston, and Dallas — receives the full 1% that was authorized by the Texas Legislature.

By 2040, San Antonio's population is expected to have grown by 1.4 million residents. VIA's Keep SA Moving plan is designed to address population growth and the associated increase in traffic.

The improvements proposed in the Keep SA Moving plan include an enhanced bus system, expanded mobility options, and a focus on innovation. Specifically, the plan provides:

- An enhanced bus system to connect more people to more places
- More frequent service to reduce wait and travel times
 More evening, late-night and weekend service
- More Mobility-on-Demand service zones
- Enhanced access for people with disabilities or mobility challenges
- Capital projects to offer a better customer experience
 Improved technology, including smart-phone apps and real-time information systems
- A foundation for future Advanced Rapid Transit, a mass-transit network that uses modern vehicles running in dedicated lanes
- Increased federal funding opportunities
