



In November 2020, San Antonio voters approved funding for the Keep SA Moving plan – an increased investment in how public transportation can move our community. VIA is ready to deliver, and Advanced Rapid Transit is a key part of KEEPING SA MOVING.

WHAT IS ADVANCED RAPID TRANSIT (ART)?

ART is a different type of public transportation that gets you where you need to go faster. It combines modern vehicles and stations, dedicated lanes and vehicle priority at traffic signals to provide frequent, reliable service that gets you past roadway congestion.

VIA identified an initial North/South corridor that would improve access and mobility for the nearly 54,000 residents and 108,000 jobs located within the corridor. This approximately 12-mile corridor extends from the San Antonio International Airport in the north, through Downtown San Antonio, to near Mission Concepción.
