SAN ANTONIO – VIA Metropolitan Transit is extending an invitation to community members to participate in a series of meetings aimed at sharing information and collecting feedback on the proposed VIA Rapid Silver Line project.

This Advanced Rapid Transit corridor is strategically designed to enhance connectivity and accessibility on the East and West sides, providing high-quality transit options to a broader demographic.

The envisioned Silver Line corridor is slated to traverse the vicinity near Our Lady of the Lake University, meandering through Downtown and culminating at the Frost Bank Center.

With an emphasis on expeditious, convenient, and cost-effective service, the Silver Line aims to retain existing ridership while attracting new patrons.

Additionally, the project seeks to stimulate job growth along the corridor, alleviate traffic congestion, and contribute to reducing greenhouse gas emissions for enhanced air quality.
